

Suffolk Community College- Early College Program

ECP provides an opportunity for academically talented high school juniors and seniors to begin earning course credit on a college campus while still enrolled in high school. Participants earn credit in a variety of courses. Advising is provided by staff of the ECP.

Students can earn up to 24 credits through ECP which can be transferred with a grade of C or higher.

Students benefit from a reduced tuition of 57 dollars per credit. Reduced tuition is available only during the fall and spring semesters. Summer or winter sessions are not eligible for reduced tuition.

Academically eligible students apply in sophomore and junior year through applications available in the guidance office. Applicants tour the campus and take a college placement exam. Transcripts and recommendations are submitted by the high school.

Classes will be offered at the Eastern Campus in the afternoons, evenings and weekend. Students will take classes with general college student population and be instructed by full time and adjunct faculty.

Students will receive a separate transcript from Suffolk Community College. Students who request to use an ECP class for high school credit requirements will need approval from guidance counselor and building principal. Then and only then will the course be placed on the HS Transcript. The course GPA will not count towards the high school cumulative GPA.

Students are responsible for their own transportation.
