Dear Parents,

Your son/daughter opted to enroll in an Advanced Placement course for the upcoming school year. Mattituck High School offers students performance guidelines necessary for success in Advanced Placement courses. However, these guidelines are not requirements for entry into these courses. Mattituck offers an **Open Enrollment Policy** allowing students and their families to opt into these courses after consideration and consultation with teachers and counselors. As such, we ask that students understand the expectations, requirements and responsibilities of enrolling in an AP course. This document is designed to outline those expectations and requirements and for 20-21 school year is being delivered via mail and to each student in their first day of class. **There will be no signatures required this year.**

**OPEN ENROLLMENT POLICY FOR AP COURSES**

1. Students will be officially enrolled in an AP course as of September 11<sup>th</sup>.
2. Students may be responsible for a summer assignment, which will be counted as a course assignment or exam. If a student fails to complete the assignment, it will count as a zero towards the first quarterly grade. The summer assignment is essential for success but non-completion will not remove students from an AP course.
3. After September 11, students may not drop an AP course until the completion of the first quarter. At that time, after a meeting with the student's guidance counselor, and permission from the School Principal, a schedule change may be granted. Students switching levels will carry the first quarter grade to the new course. Students dropping a course in which there is no lower level will have a "W" indicated on their transcript for "withdrawal from course".
4. It is expected that all students enrolled in an AP course will sit for the AP exam.
