Honor Roll Policy

The Honor Roll at Mattituck High School is calculated, printed and published by the Mattituck Junior-Senior High School Guidance Department on a quarterly basis according to the following guidelines:

1. Honor Roll will include all students in grades 7-12 having an average of 88.000% or higher.
2. High Honor Roll will include all students in grades 7-12 having an average of 93.000% or higher.
3. Grades will not be rounded off to reach either level.
4. Grades from all subjects except driver education will be included.
5. Physical Education will count as .5 in the student's average.
5. A failing grade in any subject will deem the student to be ineligible for the Honor Roll.
6. A student must be enrolled in at least four classes to be considered for Honor Roll.
7. Students with incompletes in any subject will be ineligible for Honor Roll. It is the responsibility of the student to see that an incomplete is made up and that the grade is properly recorded. Students with a "no credit" for any subject will be ineligible.
